The Digital Art Portfolio Program is designed for students who need an art portfolio as one of the application requirements for entry to art school or for multimedia arts related jobs.

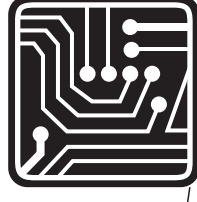
